Unfortunately, Rules Committee Republicans rejected an amendment by Ranking Member Slaughter to consider [H.Res. 861](#) under and open rule and allow every House Member to fully participate in this important debate. Therefore, **Democrats are urged to VOTE NO on the Rule.**
