Suspensions (4 bills):

- 1) **H.Res. 439** - Honoring the life and career of Willie Shoemaker and expressing the condolences of the House of Representatives to his family and friends on his death (*Rep. Reyes - Government Reform*)
- 2) **H.R. 3769** - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 137 East Young High Pike in Knoxville, Tennessee, as the "Ben Atchley Post Office Building" (*Rep. Duncan - Government Reform*)
- 3) **H.Res. 530** - Urging the appropriate representative of the United States to the 60th session of the United Nations Commission on Human Rights to introduce a resolution calling upon the Government of the People's Republic of China to end its human rights violations in China (*Rep. Smith {NJ} - International Relations*)
- 4) **H.Res. 526** - Expressing the sympathy of the House of Representatives for the victims of the devastating earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2003, in Bam, Iran (*Rep. Ney - International Relations*)
