Votes will be postponed until 6:30 p.m. **At 7:30 p.m., there will be a Members only briefing on the House floor regarding the response to Hurricane Katrina.**

### Suspensions (2 bills):

- 1) **H.Res. 360** - Commemorating the 60th anniversary of V-J Day and the end of World War II in the Pacific (*Rep. Stearns - International Relations*)
- 2) **S.J.Res. 19** - A joint resolution calling upon the President to issue a proclamation recognizing the 30th anniversary of the Helsinki Final Act (*Sen. Brownback - International Relations*)

## TOMORROW'S OUTLOOK

The GOP Leadership has announced the following schedule: on Wednesday, the House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business. The House will consider three bills under Suspension of the Rules and will also consider: **H.R. 250** - Manufacturing Technology Competitiveness Act of 2005 (*Rep.
