FLOOR SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE

The House will meet at 12:30 p.m. for morning hour and at 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. **Votes are postponed until 6:30 p.m.**

H.Res. 134 - Electing Members to the Joint Committee on Printing and the Joint Committee on the Library (Ney/Larson - House Administration) (Under Unanimous Consent)

S.Con.Res. 20 - A concurrent resolution permitting the Chairman of the Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate to designate another member of the Committee to serve on the Joint Committee on Printing in place of the Chairman (Lott - Senate Rules) (Under Unanimous Consent)

Suspensions (4 bills):

Suspension bills are debatable for 40 minutes each, may not be amended, and require two-thirds majority for passage.

Suspensions (4 bills):

- 1) H.Con.Res. 84** - A bill to replace the Kansas statue in the Capitol (Tiahrt - House Admin)
- 2) H.R. 620** - To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to provide supplemental funding and other services that are necessary to assist the State of California or local educational agencies in California in providing educational services for students attending schools located within the Park (Radanovich - Resources).
- 3) H.R. 788** - To revise the boundary of the Glen Canyon National Recreation Area in the States of Utah and Arizona (Cannon - Resources).
- 4) H.R. 961** - To promote Department of the Interior efforts to provide a scientific basis for the management of sediment and nutrient loss in the Upper Mississippi River Basin (Kind, Costello, Kennedy, Leach, Gutknecht, Kildee - Resources).
