## Motion to Recommit H.R. 840 – Veterans Access to Child Care Act

Mr. Barr moved to recommit with instructions to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of section 1730D of title 38, United States Code, as proposed to be added by section 2 of the bill, add the following new subsection:

- "(e) ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD CARE PROVIDERS.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), no payment may be made under this section to a child care center, child care agency, or child care provider described in subsection (b) that employs an individual who has been charged with—
- "(A) a sex offense;
- '(B) an offense involving a child victim;
- "(C) a violent crime;
- "(D) a drug felony; or
- "(E) other offense that the Secretary deter mines appropriate.
- "(2) Payment may be made under this section to a child care center, child care agency, or child care provider described in subsection (b) if such child care center, child care agency, or child care provider has suspended the individual described in paragraph (1) from having any contact with children while on the job until the case is resolved."
