

MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

M_____ moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 2203, to the Committee on Homeland Security with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add, at the end of section 711 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (as proposed to be added by section 1 of the bill), the following:

1 “(k) PROTECTIONS FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME IN SANC-
2 TUARY CITIES.—

3 “(1) RECEIPT OF COMPLAINTS.—The Ombuds-
4 man shall use the process established under sub-
5 section (b) to receive complaints—

6 “(A) from victims of crimes committed by
7 aliens unlawfully present in the United States
8 when such crimes occur in sanctuary jurisdic-
9 tions; and

10 “(B) regarding the impact of illegal immi-
11 gration on communities located in sanctuary ju-
12 risdictions from individuals within such jurisdic-
13 tions.

1 “(2) INCLUSION IN REPORTS.—The Ombuds-
2 man shall include in the report submitted under sub-
3 section (d) the following:

4 “(A) The names of each sanctuary juris-
5 diction from which a complaint under para-
6 graph (1) was received.

7 “(B) Information regarding whether a de-
8 tainer request was issued by U.S. Immigration
9 and Customs Enforcement for an alien related
10 to a complaint and whether such detainer was
11 acted upon by the relevant sanctuary jurisdic-
12 tion.

13 “(C) Any complaint pattern that could be
14 prevented or reduced by policy or practice
15 changes by sanctuary jurisdictions.

16 “(D) Other information or recommenda-
17 tions, as determined appropriate by the Om-
18 budsman.

19 “(3) DEFINITION.—The term ‘sanctuary juris-
20 diction’ means a State or local government that has
21 in effect on the effective date of this section a law,
22 regulation, or policy that prohibits or in any way re-
23 stricts a Federal, State, or local government entity,
24 official, or other personnel from complying with the
25 immigration laws (as defined in section 101(a)(17)

1 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
2 1101(a)(17))), or from assisting or cooperating with
3 Federal law enforcement entities, officials, or other
4 personnel regarding the enforcement of such laws.”.
