The House will meet again at approximately 8:35 p.m. in a joint session with the Senate for the purposes of receiving an address from the President of the United States. **Members are requested to be on the Floor and seated no later than 8:25 p.m.**

Last votes expected: 4:00 – 5:00 p.m.
