Consideration of the Veto Message on [H.J.Res. 88](#) – Disapproving the rule submitted by the Department of Labor relating to the definition of the term “Fiduciary” (Rep. Roe – Education and the Workforce)

Begin Consideration of [H.R. 5485](#) – Financial Services and General Government Appropriations Act, 2017 (Rep. Crenshaw – Appropriations) (Subject to a Rule)
