First votes expected: 3:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Suspension (1 bill)

1. [H.R. 2646](#) – Helping Families in Mental Health Crisis Act of 2016, as amended (Rep. Murphy (PA) – Energy and Commerce)

The Rule, which was adopted today, provides for one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Ways and Means.

[H.R. 4361](#) – The Federal Information Systems Safeguards Act of 2016 (Rep. Palmer – Oversight and Government Reform) (Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for one hour of general debate and makes in order the following amendments:
