"One Minutes" (5 per side)

[S.Con.Res. 3](#) – Setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2017 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2018 through 2026 (Sen. Enzi – Budget) (Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for 90 minutes of general debate controlled by the Budget Committee, 30 minutes of general debate controlled by the Joint Economic Committee, and makes in order the following amendment:

Yarmuth Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute (20 minutes of debate)

[S. 84](#) – To provide for an exception to a limitation against appointment of persons as Secretary of Defense within seven years of relief from active duty as a regular commissioned officer of the Armed Forces (Sen. McCain – Armed Services) (Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for 90 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Armed Services.
