[H.J.Res. 123](#) – The Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018 (Rep. Frelinghuysen – Appropriations)
(Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Appropriations.

[H.R. 477](#) – Small Business Mergers, Acquisitions, Sales, and Brokerage Simplification Act of 2017 (Rep. Huizenga – Financial Services) (Subject to a Rule)

The Rule provides for one hour of general debate and makes in the order the following amendment:
