1. [H.R. 5693](#) – Long-Term Care Veterans Choice Act, as amended (Rep. Higgins (LA) – Veterans' Affairs)
2. **Concurring in the Senate Amendment to [H.R. 2353](#)** – Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Rep. Thompson (PA) – Education and the Workforce)
3. [H.Res. 981](#) – Condemning the violence, persecution, intimidation, and murders committed by the Government of Nicaragua against its citizens, as amended (Rep. Ros-Lehtinen – Foreign Affairs)

7. [H.Res. 1009](#) – Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the lack of timely and predictable funding unnecessarily undermines the mission of the United States Special Operations Command and jeopardizes the security of the United States (Rep. Hudson – Armed Services)

[H.Res. 1010](#) – Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the United States Air Force faces significant readiness challenges due to insufficient personnel levels, a shrinking and depleted aircraft fleet, and maintenance deferrals, all of which are affected by budgetary uncertainty and impede the Air Force's ability to meet ongoing and unexpected national security threats, putting United States national security at risk (Rep. Arrington – Armed Services)
9. [H.Res. 1007](#) – Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that not fully resourcing the United States Army in a timely manner erodes the Army's ability to maintain readiness and poses risk to the Army's ability to conduct military operations (Rep. Russell – Armed Services)
