- Monday, May 2, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. to report a Rule for **H.R. 1213** – To Repeal the Mandatory Funding Provided to States in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to Establish American Health Benefit Exchanges. We expect a Structured Rule and Amendments must be submitted to the Rules Committee by **10:00 a.m. on Monday, May 2, 2011**.
- Monday, May 2, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. to report a Rule for **H.R. 1214** – To Repeal Mandatory Funding for School-Based Health Center Construction. We expect a Modified Structured Rule which may require that amendments be pre-printed in the Congressional Record prior to their consideration. Amendments should be submitted for printing in the Congressional Record on the legislative day of **Monday, May 2, 2011**.
- Monday, May 2, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. to report a Rule for **H.R. 3** – No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act. We expect a Closed Rule.
- Wednesday, May 4, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. to report a Rule for **H.R. 1229** – Putting the Gulf of Mexico Back to Work Act and **H.R. 1230** – To require the Secretary of the Interior to conduct certain offshore oil and gas lease sales. We expect a Structured Rule for both bills. Amendments for H.R. 1229 must be submitted to the Rules Committee by **10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 3, 2011** and Amendments for H.R. 1230 must be submitted to the Rules Committee by **10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 4, 2011**.
