At approximately 11:00 a.m., the House will convene in a Joint Meeting with the Senate for the purpose of receiving an address from **The Honorable Benjamin Netanyahu, Prime Minister of Israel**. On Wednesday, the House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for Morning Hour debate and 12:00 p.m. for legislative business. On Thursday, the House will meet at 9:00 a.m. for legislative business with last votes no later than 3:00 p.m. On Friday, the House will meet in pro forma session. No votes are expected in the House.

We expect a Modified Structured Rule which may require that amendments be pre-printed in the Congressional Record prior to their consideration. Amendments should be submitted for printing in the Congressional Record on the legislative day of **Monday, May 23, 2011.**
